CRIBS FOR KIDS



Indiana Safe Sleep/Cribs for Kids is an educational safe sleep program that provides a portable crib (pack n play), crib sheet, wearable blanket, pacifier, and educational materials in order to promote safe sleep, and prevent SIDS.

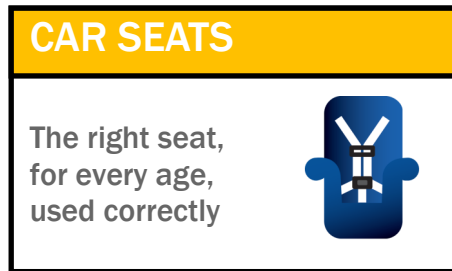
Pack n plays may be provided for parents with financial need who do not have a safe place for their baby to sleep. Baby must be under one year old and weigh less than 30 lbs.

Expecting parents are eligible in their third trimester. You must fill out a safe sleep form and watch an educational DVD. You will receive instruction and a demonstration on assembly.

Educational programs on safe sleep are available at no charge.

CAR SEATS



The Car Seat Safety Program includes a permanent fitting station at Family Service Association to provide car seats and education on installation.

The Car Seat Safety program serves Indiana residents. Expecting parents are eligible in the third trimester. Car seats may be provided to those who qualify for financial assistance (child must be present).

This program is offered by appointment only and often has a waiting list. If you are interested, please call to schedule a car seat checkup. Education on installation is available to all Indiana residents.

GEAR UP



The Gear Up program includes an initial home visit to assess safety needs in your home, a second home visit to provide equipment and education, and follow up. An assessment worker will help identify areas that need childproofing.

Examples of equipment that may be provided include: baby gates, baby monitors, fire extinguishers, portable cribs, cabinet latches, and door and window alarms.

To qualify for the program, you must be a resident of Howard or Miami County, have at least one child under 5 years old, and have an agency referral.
